Mission Arlington Dress Code & Guidelines

Mission Arlington's dress code is very basic. We ask all participants to dress modestly, comfortably, and in something where they are ready to work. Casual dress is fine all week long. Here are a few specific requests we make of all groups:

- ⇒ Shorts are fine all week long. Please no short shorts.
- ⇒ Footwear is up to you, but because we do so much work and active play outside we recommend tennis shoes over flip-flops.
- ⇒ Please remember that there are certain things you might wear at home working outside in the heat but that may not be the right image for knocking on doors and asking parents to let their children go with you. Because of this, please follow these additional guidelines all week long:
- ⇒ T-shirts are great to wear, but please no tank tops or any other kinds of sleeveless shirts.
- ⇒ Baseball caps are fine, but please wear forward at all times. Do not wear bandanas or any other type of head gear. (Winter headgear is okay if it's cold.)

Note—if you choose to dress in something that does not fit with our dress code, a Mission Arlington staff member *will* ask you to change before you begin your day's assignments. This only slows down your group and gives you less time to effectively minister during the day. So, please stick to the dress code.

Be flexible and unpack only what you need each day: Mission Arlington/Mission Metroplex is a very busy place. All of our facilities are constantly being used to reach people for the Lord.

A daily backpack

This optional suggestion is borrowed from some of our groups, and it has worked great for them. Have everybody bring a backpack with any or all of the following items:

- ♦ Bible: keep it with you all the time. It will be your most important lifeline for the week.
- ♦ Extra Bibles to give away
- ♦ Candy or small prizes to give away
- ♦ Trash bags for cleaning up while you are at Rainbow Express
- ♦ Water bottle (*very* good idea)
- ♦ Candy or small prizes to give away

F.A.Q.'s

What can I pack for the bus ride?

You may take ONE small to medium sized carry-on. Snacks and drinks are fine. **NO MONSTER DRINKS!** **NO** personal DVD players or other video playing devices....and no whining about it either. Cards and other travel games are a good idea, too.

What to bring?

Bring your own toiletries such as toothbrush, shampoo and soap, deodorant. Don't forget your Bibles, notepad and pen. We are working outside in the heat, so sunscreen, WATER BOTTLE, closed toed shoes, and sunglasses are recommended.

What **not** to bring?

Please leave video players, electronic games, **cell phones**, iPods, roller blades, wheelies, and skateboards **at home**. We are on mission and need to **BE ALL THERE** during the trip. **No** water guns, water balloons, or weapons of any kind. **No** drugs, alcohol or tobacco products. It's an expensive trip home.

Dear girls, please bring the necessary "girly" stuff you may need to get you through the Mission Trip. You know what I'm talking about. We will have an assortment of "girly" stuff on the trip should you run into any unexpected problems.
